Though the excitement and tension never releases its grip on the reader, their dynamics undergo subtle and enticing changes as the story progresses on a physical level from the rugged terrain and waterways of America's back-country to the dust and terror of Iraq, and along a metaphysical journey of humanity's eternal struggle with greed, power, trauma and love.

Through artfully varied and brilliantly conceived characters these quintessential aspects of life we all as individuals have to suffer and bear, Murray explores mankind's darkest desires and highest hopes.
